Professor Martin Guggenheim is one of the nation's leading experts on juvenile law. Prof. Guggenheim successfully argued the landmark U.S. Supreme Court case Santosky v. Kramer in which the court raised the standard of proof required to terminate parental rights.

A former Acting Director of the American Civil Liberties Foundation Juvenile Rights Project, Prof. Guggenheim is co-author of four books, including The Rights of Families, The Rights of Young People, and The Rights of Parents.

The Honorable Lynda B. Munro brings her extensive experience as a Family Court Judge to this program. She has served as Presiding Judge over the Family Division in the New Haven Judicial District, Presiding Judge over the Regional Family Trial Docket in Middletown, Presiding Judge for Family Matters in the New Haven Judicial District, and most recently she served as Presiding Judge for Family Matters in the Stamford Judicial District.

She also was a member of the Governor's Commission on Divorce, Custody and Family. Judge Munro has taught many courses to the trial bench as well as seminars for the organized bar.
